Every horse/pony competing at this show must be accompanied by a valid equine passport with proof of up to date vaccinations. No photocopies will be accepted. Any persons not able to present these documents will not be allowed to compete and may forfeit their entry fee. They will also be required to leave the showground immediately.

Team Composition

Teams can be made up of 3 or 4 different riders. Horses/ponies can be ridden twice on the same team if ridden by two different riders, but the horse/pony cannot be ridden in more than two tests on any one competition day. A rider may not ride more than once for a team (i.e. a rider with two horses). A rider may compete on multiple teams. Please notify us of your chosen '**Team Name**' and team members on the entry form.

Teams can be made up of riders competing in any level of test (i.e. a team of 4 Intro riders or 4 Novice riders or any combination of each of the levels available). Restrictions of riders will apply.

Smart casual turnout of competitors is required. Safety is paramount, so appropriate riding footwear and protective headwear in accordance to BD rules must be worn. Jackets are not compulsory, and teams are encouraged to wear 'team colours' of their choice. This can be an appropriate shirt/t-shirt with short or long sleeves. Sleeveless shirts will **not** be permitted.

Restrictions

Walk and Trot classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have been placed at Prelim level or above.

Preliminary classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have won at Novice level or above.

Novice classes are open to Horse & Rider combination never to have won at Elementary level or above.

Elementary/Medium classes are open to all.

Scoring

The winning team is the one having the highest combined percentage of their three riders. If teams achieve the same total percentage, the winning team is the one whose lowest scoring team member has the highest percentage. Individual placings in each of the classes will occur if sufficient entries are received.
