Clear round jumping will be held from 10 am until 10.30 am and will remain at the height of the first class or taken down to cross poles. Each clear round is £5, and tickets can be purchased from the show secretaries hut. No clear round tickets will be sold after 10.20 am.

Competitors who go clear in section 1 will go straight on to the jump off section of the course, where if there is equality of faults time will decide.

Please note: Class 1 is aimed at genuine Beginner riders only. Any riders who the judge deems to be unsuitable for the class will be asked to move up to Novice level at future shows. Competitors maybe assisted or lead in this class. If a rider is being led in the class, then the leader must be wearing a suitable hard riding hat, whilst in the ring.

Any horse/pony and rider combination entering class 1 will not be permitted to enter classes 3-5. All horses/ponies will be limited to two classes and two clear rounds per show.

Performance Award

This year we will be making an award to the most improved Horse/Rider combination from the season. This will be based on the combination's performances, style and improved progression throughout the series.
