## Important Notice regarding Passports and Vaccinations

**\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*** It is a rule of entry to the show that all equines are up to date with their Annual FLU vaccinations, and proof will be required when you make your on-line entry. Your passport is checked before competing. Any persons not able to upload these documents on to their Horse Monkey account will not be permitted to make an entry. If you have any enquiries regarding the vaccination policy, please contact the show secretary before commencing with your on-line entry.

All entries to be made on-line via **Horse Monkey**. Entries close the Thursday before each show. No email/ telephone entries will be accepted. No entries will be taken on the day.

**Important:** All competitors will be allocated an individual time to come forward to jump their rounds. Competitors that are not present at the ringside for their allotted time will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition. Competition times will be emailed out to all competitors on the Friday before each show.

Competitors who go clear in section 1 (fences 1-8) will go straight on to the jump off section of the course (fences 9-14) where if there is equality of faults, time will decide.

**Please note:** Class 2 is aimed at genuine beginner riders only. Any riders who the judge deems to be unsuitable for the class will be asked to move up to Novice level at future shows. Competitors may be assisted or lead in this class. If a rider is being led in the class, then the leader must be wearing a suitable hard riding hat whilst in the ring.

Any horse/pony and rider combination entering class 2 will not be permitted to enter classes 4-6. All horses/ponies will be limited to two classes and two clear rounds per show.
